TOILET MEASURING

WHAT IS YOUR TOILET ROUGH-IN?
 Before you order a toilet you should check the Rough-In dimension. Measure from the finished wall to the center of the bolt caps. Standard toilets are 12", but some models are available in 10" or 14"

As you shop for a new toilet, there are a few things you'll want to consider along with sizes and style.



One- Vs. Two-Piece

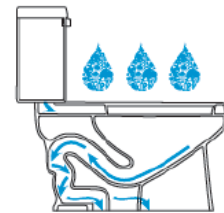
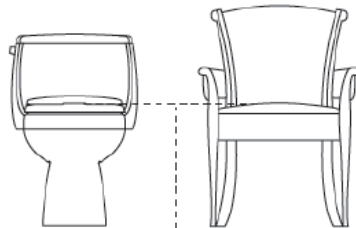
One Piece- Integrated tank and bowl.
 Two Piece- separate tank and bowl.

Bowl Shape

Round Bowl,
 Elongated Bowl,
 Compact Bowl & Tank

Concealed & Skirted Trapways

Makes for a smoother surface and easier to clean, but more expensive to manufacture.



Flushing Technology

Standard Gravity, Pressure Assisted, Dual Flush, Large Flapper Flush, Cylinder Flush, Cyclone Flush, Auto Flush and more.

Comfort Height®

Are typically 2-3 inches taller. Any toilet that is 17-19 inches from floor to the top of the seat is considered Comfort Height. Some are also ADA compliant.

Gallons per Flush

0.6 to 1.6 gpf (gallons per flush)
